Easter Dues envelopes are now available at the back of the church for those who do not use the envelope system. If you are using the envelopes available at church, and are planning to apply for charity tax rebate, please write your name and envelope number on envelope.

What are Dues Envelopes? The Easter Dues envelopes along with Christmas and Autumn Dues pay the salary of the priest of the parish, diocesan levy (calculated by curate's salary) and contribute to the support of retired clergy, clergy working in offices and clergy in underprivileged areas of the diocese.

What is the Weekly Offertory Collection for then? It is a common misunderstanding that the weekly offertory collection is for the priest. In actual fact, the weekly offertory collections is for the upkeep and running of the parish. It does not form any part of the priest's income or salary. Thank you in advance for your continued support & generosity in these difficult and challenging times.

As We Fall Silent

The tragedy of this week has left the area numb and shocked. As the reality begins to become real, there can be a sense of aimlessness and confusion as to how the lives of two young people could be so cruelly taken away like this. This shock and numbness, the sense of aimlessness and confusion, along with other emotions people feel and experience are not 'not normal'. These feelings and experiences are in fact grief.

It is only in movies and Hollywood stories that people say the right thing like, 'I love you' or 'I am sorry' and only in the world of 'make believe' that death comes to muted moving strains of an orchestra. While experiencing loss is part of any life – leaving homes for college or marriage, watching children on the first day of school, it is possible to become 'stuck in grief'. Bereavement brings chaos into our hearts, and failing to recognise what it is, we try to bury it.

The Chinese have a proverb, 'never trust a man whose belly does not move when he laughs'. Grief is real and is something to be felt and experienced. Many want to avoid grieving and bereavement, not just to avoid the pain but also the reality of denial – 'if I do not grieve, I am not reminded, and it is therefore not real'. Bereavement is a pilgrimage, where eventually, we have to face the reality of loss, and feel the pain in one of life's greatest upheavals. Bereavement will not bring back the person nor imply things will be back to what they were, but it does allow the construction of a new life from the rubble.

It can come to a person at any particular time, without permission and without apology – pain, tears, anger, laughter, sadness, denial to mention a few traits. Grief recognising other grief can also be stirred up by the losses and grief of others. The loss of a loved one utterly transforms the landscape of a person's life – their world has been turned upside down. Grief is a slow process that calls for patience, compassion and understanding, courage and strength.

As the kids return to school this week, where do we begin to support them and ourselves? One step I would suggest to parents and guardians, 'hug your child and tell them you love them' and to the kids, I would suggest, forget the coolness and awkwardness, AND hug your moms and dads, and tell them you love them! They need it now as much as you. This way you know that you are together for the path ahead.



May the gentle souls of Kirsty & Lukas rest in peace. Amen.

May all holy men and women, and those in our own families, who have gone before us, watch over the families of Kirsty & Lukas. Amen

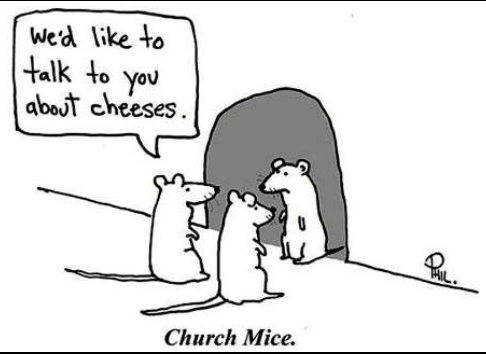
