Thirty years ago, damage to the ozone layer was a huge global problem. The ozone layer protects the earth from UV radiation which can cause skin cancer. The damage was caused by CFCs (chlorofluorocarbons) used in aerosols and refrigerators. Thanks to the phasing out of these two agents, the ozone layer has been largely regenerated and it is estimated that by 2030, two million cases of skin cancer will be avoided. This success story should encourage us in our efforts to reduce global warming by controlling carbon emissions today.
