<u>Did you know it is an offence to allow your pet to foul in a public area</u>. Pet owners who fail to clean up after their animals face on the spot fines of  $\in 150$  rising to  $\in 3,000$  for those convicted of not paying the original penalty. While the majority of dog owners take full responsibility for their pets behaviour, there is a small minority of owners who do not clean up after their dogs whilst out walking. Contact with dog excrement can cause toxocariass which can lead to illness such as dizziness, nausea, asthma or seizures and can also contain Ecoli and other parasites which can cause loss of vision. Please think of others in the community who like to walk the same paths/roadways, especially older people and those with young children.
