**Feast of St Brigid** is on this Thursday and Mass will be in Straide at 10.00am. St Brigid's Crosses can be left in the church any time before Mass on Wednesday (Bohola) or Thursday for blessing. Please attach your name so that you can collect them later in the church if you so wish. Crosses will also be blessed at the Bohola Mass on Wednesday morning. I'm sure St. Brigid won't mind doing an early shift!

St Brigid is renowned for her hospitality, almsgiving and care of the sick. She is the patron saint of poets, beggars, refugees, midwives, those in childbirth, newborn babies and no doubt many more. The St Brigid's Cross, in legend used by Brigid to explain the Christian faith, remains a popular sign of God's protection.

**Feast of The Presentation of the Lord** is on Friday and Mass will be in Straide at 10.00am. This day is also known as **Candlemas Day** when traditionally, candles are blessed. If anyone wishes to have candles blessed, again leave them in the church beforehand with name attached and they can be collected anytime afterwards. Candles will also be blessed in Bohola on Wednesday morning for anyone who wishes to have candles blessed there.

**Feast of St Blaise** is on Saturday. St Blaise is associated with the blessing of throats and we will endeavour to bless throats at all Masses next weekend.
