Centering Prayer emphasizes interior silence and prayer as a personal relationship with God and as "a movement beyond conversation with Christ to communion with Christ." Its roots are found in the contemplative prayer of the Desert Fathers of early Christian monasticism, in the Lectio Divina tradition, and in Christian mystical works like The Cloud of Unknowing and the writings of St. Teresa of Avila and St. John of the Cross.
