The **Deadline** for items for inclusion in the Parish Newsletter is **12 noon** each Friday.

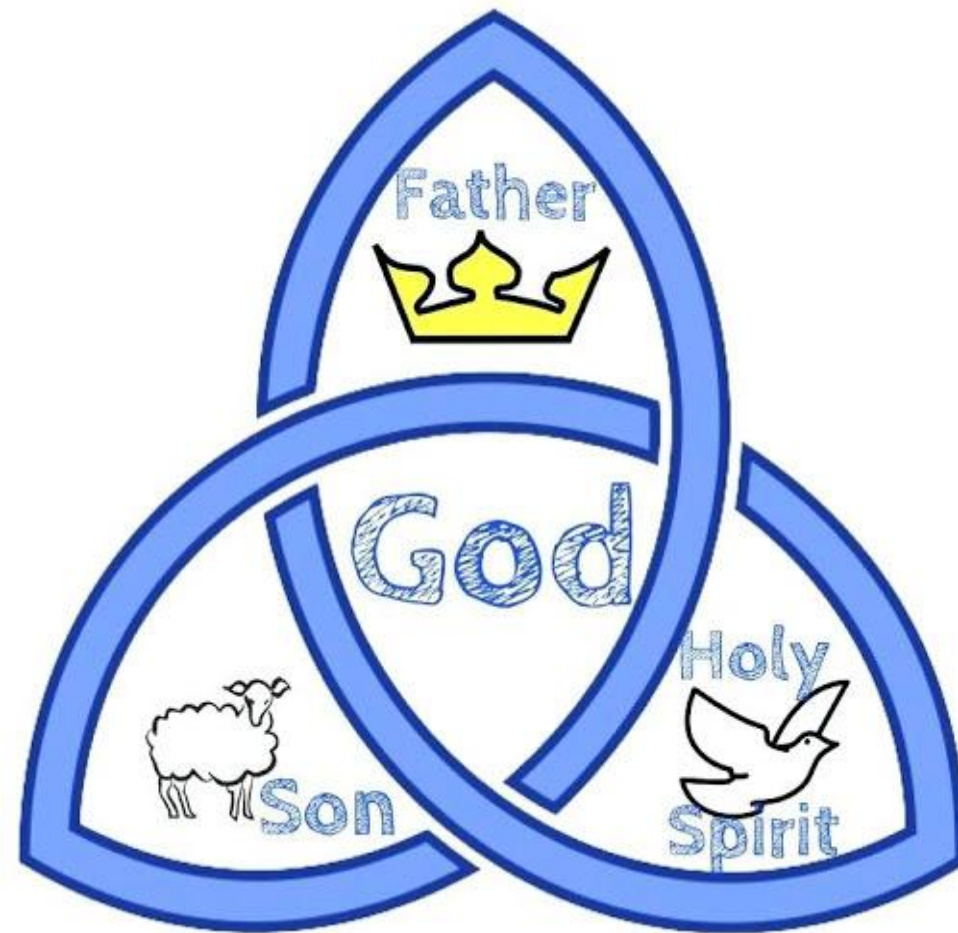
