## HISTORY OF MCMAHON PARK

An idea conceived by the youth of Claremorris Foróige Club in 1988 to transform an industrial waste-land around Clare Lake became the basis of what is today this family amenity. The Clare Lake Committee was formed to bring this vision to life and following on from the donation of land from the Mc Mahon Family, work got underway the following year. The McMahon Park Committee received further donations of land from the Boyle and McHugh families and from Mayo County Council, which enabled the creation of the Clare Lake Loop. The extension in 2011 to create Clare Lake Forest Greenway was made possible with the support of the landowners, the Keane and O'Brien families and Coillte.
