Advent Adoration in Straide: Due to unforeseen circumstances, there will be no Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in Straide on this Tuesday, 29<sup>th</sup> but Adoration will go ahead on the remaining Tuesdays of Advent (December 6<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup>) at 7.00pm.



Bambinelli Sunday, December 4<sup>th</sup>: For the past several decades, each year on Gaudete Sunday, the Third Sunday of Advent, children (and adults) bring their Baby Jesus figures from the crib at their homes to St. Peter's Square where the Pope blesses both the people and the figurines during the Angelus. This year we will celebrate "Bambinelli Sunday" at all Masses next weekend, December 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> to tie in with the Grow in Love First Communion programme but not confined to those children. All are invited to bring the Baby Jesus figure from their homes for blessing at Mass. Families can even make their own "bambinelli" if they want. It is suggested

that following the blessing, you take your "bambinelli" home and place it in a gift box, wrap it, and save it for Christmas. Let this be the first gift your family opens at Christmas, when together you place your Baby Jesus figure in the crib, and have a home blessing of the Nativity for your whole family.
