Notice from SEC Thuar Mhic Éadaigh: The Sustainable Energy Community (SEC) Thuar Mhic Éadaigh Committee are pleased to invite you to attend a drop-in clinic on the "Warmer Homes" SEAI energy scheme in Halla Thuar Mhic Éadaigh on Thursday 21st April from 11am to 2pm.

A qualified energy mentor (under the SEAI mentoring scheme) will attend the clinic and go through on a one-to-one basis the application form, what type of energy works can be undertaken under this scheme and timelines. Approved works are funded at 100% under this scheme.

To be eligible to participate in the scheme homeowner must be in receipt of one of the following payments from the state: Fuel Allowance as part of the National Fuel Scheme;

Job Seekers Allowance for over six months and have a child under seven years of age; Working Family Payment. One-Parent Family Payment. Domiciliary Care Allowance. Carers Allowance and live with the person you are caring for.

You must not have participated in or received the benefit of works to your home previously under the Scheme.

Eligible persons must also be a homeowner and live in your own home.

House must have been built and occupied before 1 January 2006.
