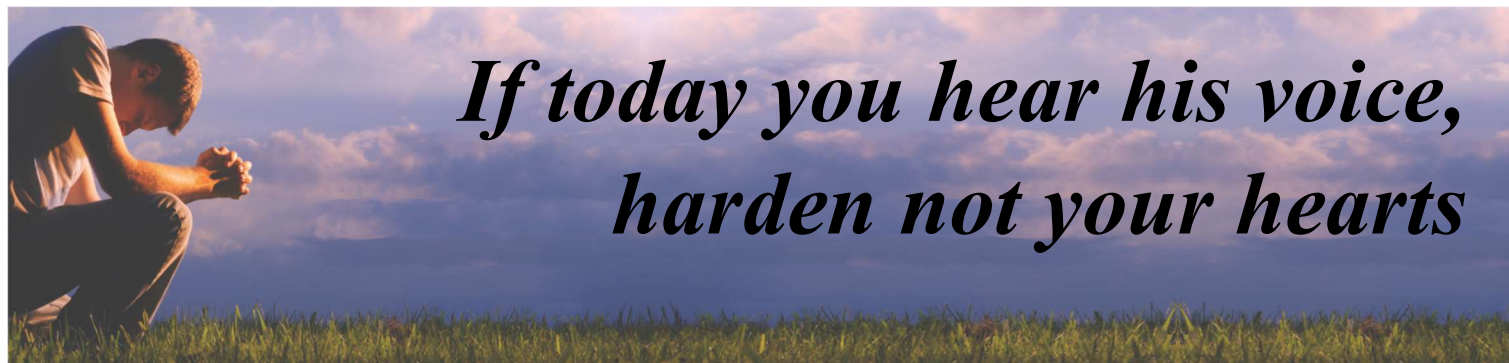

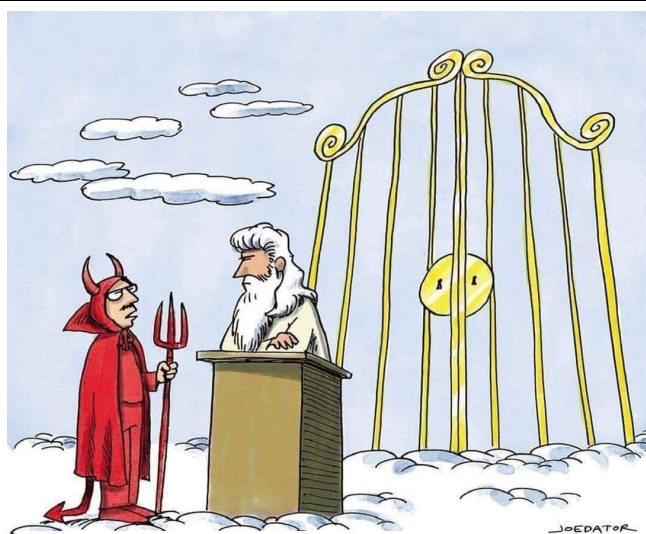
Start time is **10AM until 5PM**, fee is €10 for adults, Children free. Signs and guidance to Glencorrib will be in place this weekend to assist visitors.
