I rith mí na Bealtaine, beidh **Gráinne Hamby**, an cláirseoir mór le rá, ag tabhairt cuairt ar roinnt aonaid altranais phobail i gcontae Mhaigh Eo agus beidh sí ag tabhairt a ceol binn léi a fhad is go mbeidh na daoine a bhfuil ina gcónaí faoi chúram cónaithe sin í a chloisteáil. Tá clú agus cáil ar Ghráinne maidir leis a léirithe beo agus lena hábhair taifeadta ar fad, éachtaí nach beag ina léirítear a 'máistreacht iomlán ar an gcláirseach Éireannach'. Bainfidh gach cónaitheoir an-sásamh as an gceol le linn mí na Bealtaine.

Aithnítear Gráinne Hambly, ó Mhainistir Mhaigh Eo, mar mháistir na cláirsí ar bhonn idirnáisiúnta, agus tá an-éileamh uirthi faoi láthair mar thaibheoir agus mar mhúinteoir araon, idir anseo agus thar lear. Bhain sí a céim sa cheol amach ó Ollscoil na Banríona, Béal Feirste agus thacaigh sí agus thaifead sí le roinnt ceoltóirí éagsúla. Mar aon le sin, sheinn sí sa tSeapáin, sa Bhrasaíl agus sa Cholóim, chomh maith le cuid mhór cuairteanna go SAM.

Tá an Scéim Chláraithe Feidhmíochta Beo Áitiúil maoinithe ag an Roinn Turasóireachta, Cultúir, Ealaíon, Gaeltachta, Spóirt agus Meán agus á riar ag Comhairle Contae Mhaigh Eo.

In May, acclaimed harpist **Gráinne Hamby** will visit a selection of pre-booked Care Nursing Units in County Mayo, bringing the joy of music to those living in residential nursing care. Gráinne has attracted glowing praise for her live performances and recorded material, which brilliantly showcase what has been described as her 'absolute mastery of the Irish harp'. Residents will enjoy a musical delight during the month of May.

Gráinne Hambly, from Mayo Abbey, is an internationally recognised exponent of the Irish harp, and is in great demand as a performer and teacher, both at home and abroad. She studied music at Queen's University Belfast and has toured and recorded with various artists, including performances as far afield as Japan, Brazil and Colombia as well as frequent tours to the USA.

Beidh an t-ealaíontóir **Mags Duffy** ag comhoibriú le daoine ar leith ó Chathair na Mart a chuaigh ar scor ach a bhí ag úsáid raon mór de scileanna agus iad ag déanamh a n-obair laethúil; beidh iascaire/ duine a chruthaigh prócaí amach as gliomaigh agus coll, tógálaí balla cloiche/ saor cloiche agus gúnadóir/ bróidnéir ina measc.

Agus iad ag breathnú ar chúrsaí cleachtais ealaíne agus ceardaíocht traidisiúnta le chéile, beidh an comhshaothar seo ag díriú isteach ar bhríonna agus ar luachanna na ceardaíochta traidisiúnta agus na healaíne comhaimseartha araon. Beidh an grúpa in ann a gcuid scileanna a roinnt agus ansin na scileanna a phlé ó thaobh tábhacht de agus an dóigh a n-úsáidtear faoi láthair iad.

Is amharcealaíontóir í Mags Duffy atá lonnaithe i gCathair an Mart, Contae Mhaigh Eo a bhfuil cúlra de theicstílí trialacha agus iarchéim le hoideachas sna healaíona aici. Tá sí ag teagasc agus ag reáchtáil tionscadail an phobail le tríocha bliain anuas. Bhain sí an Duais Lúfaireachta ón Chomhairle Ealaíon amach sa bhliain 2021.

Artist **Mags Duffy** will work with retired Westport based individuals who, in their working lives, employed a range of skills as part of their daily work tasks including; a fisherman/maker of hazel lobster pots, a stone wall builder/mason and a dress maker/embroiderer.

Looking at ideas of arts practice and traditional crafting, this collaboration will look at the meaning and value of traditional craft and contemporary art. The group will be invited to share the skills used in their daily work lives and have conversations about the importance of the skill and how it is used today.

Mags Duffy is a visual artist based in Westport, Co. Mayo. She has a background in experimental textiles and a postgraduate qualification in arts education. She has been involved in teaching and community projects for the past thirty years. She is the recipient of a 2021 Arts Council Agility Award.

Tionscadal Meantóireachta na gCeoltóirí. Tá lúcháir ar Sheirbhís na nEalaíon de chuid Comhairle Contae Mhaigh Eo Tionscadal meantóireachta na gCeoltóirí ó ghlúin go glúin a chur ar fáil mar chuid de chlár Bhealtaine i mbliana. Beidh John Hoban, cumadóir, amhránaí, ceoltóir agus údar ó Chaisleán an Bharraigh ag obair go dlúth leis an sárghliúiteadóir Tim McHugh ó Bhaile Uí Fhiacháin.

Cuireann John a chasadh domhain taitneamhach nádúrtha féin ar cheol traidisiúnta na hÉireann. Is ceoltóir den scoth é a bhfuil máistreacht aige leis an bhfidil, an bainseó, na feadóga, an mhandaiveidhil agus roinnt uirlisí eile. Mar aon le sin is amhránaí agus cumadóir amhráin agus ceolta é.

Thosaigh Tim ag foghlaim an cheoil traidisiúnta agus é 9 mbliana d'aois agus faoin am a raibh sé ina dhéagóir bhí sé ag seinm go háitiúil le ceoltóirí áitiúla Mhaigh Eo. Tá an tionchar ag an bhfidil agus ag an bhfeadóga ó Mhaigh Eo Thoir agus ó Shligeach Theas aige. Sheinn sé agus theagaisc sé in Éirinn, san Eoraip, sna SAM agus san Afraic.

Beidh roinnt mhaith seisiún meantóireachta ag John agus Tim le chéile le linn mí na Bealtaine mar chuid den fhéile Bhealtaine.



For this year's Bealtaine Celebrations, Mayo County Council Arts Service is delighted to offer an intergenerational Artist Mentoring Project. Castlebar based composer, singer, musician and author, John Hoban will work with Newport based flute player Tim McHugh.

John combines the best of the Irish tradition with an intimate, warm and raw sensibility that is his own. He is an accomplished player of fiddle, banjo, whistles, mandocello, and other instruments, in addition to being a singer and composer of songs and music.

Tim started learning traditional music around the age of 9 and in his late teens, he began playing locally in sessions and learning music from local Mayo musicians. He is greatly influenced by the fiddle and flute music of East Mayo and South Sligo. He has performed and taught throughout Ireland, Europe, USA and Africa.

John and Tim will have several mentoring sessions together beginning in May to mark Bealtaine.

Is i **Norah Brennan**, amharcealaíontóir a bhfuil duaiseanna buailte aici agus céim chéadonóracha i Mínealaín aici. Is saineolaí maidir le déanamh priontaí í agus bíonn sí ag obair óna stiúideo ceardlanna féin (cló sa chró) i gClár Chlainne Mhuiris agus tá sí ina ball de Dhéantóirí Priontaí Luimnigh. Bhí cuid mhór léirithe aonair aici in Éirinn agus i dTuaisceart na hÉireann chomh maith le cuid léirithe grúpa eile in Éirinn agus thar lear mar shampla i Meiriceá, sa Fhrainc, san Astráil agus sa RA.
