### Prayer in honour of St. Blaise

*O GOD, deliver us through the intercession of Thy holy bishop and martyr Blaise from all evil of soul and body, especially from all ills of the throat; and grant us the grace to make a good confession in the confident hope of obtaining Thy pardon, and ever to praise with worthy lips Thy most holy name.*

Saint Blaise was the Bishop of Sebaste in Armenia (modern Turkey) around 1,700 years ago. He left Sebaste to escape persecution and made his home in a mountain cave and lived there, surrounded by wild animals, until he was arrested.

On his way to prison, he met a mother whose son was choking to death on a fish bone. He cured the boy and to show her gratitude, the mother brought candles to light his prison cell. In prison he was asked to renounce his faith, but he refused and was beaten with wool combs and beheaded.

After his death, he was made a saint and has become the Patron Saint of wool combers, wild animals, candle makers and ailments of the throat.
