We are delighted that you can once again attend Mass in your local church and look forward to welcoming you back. However as only 50 people are allowed in the church at any one time we ask that you please adhere to the following:

- 2 metre distance to be Maintained
- Follow the Stewards Instructions at all times
- Adults and teenagers must wear a Mask at all Church Ceremonies
- Communion must be received on the hand
- Hand Sanitisers are at every entrance and exit of the church
