#### Fire Services – Community Fire Safety:

As part of our CFS initiatives, we have recently conducted a comprehensive training program aimed at enhancing firefighters' ability to conduct Home Fire Safety Visits. Our colleagues from An Garda Síochána and Age Friendly Ireland also attended as their participation is key to developing a collaborative, inter-agency approach to expanding this important community safety initiative.

The training also featured valuable contributions from EI Electronics, who provided indepth instruction on the installation, operation, and maintenance of smoke, heat, and carbon monoxide detectors. This partnership ensures that our teams are well-equipped with the latest knowledge and tools to safeguard homes across the county.
