HANRAHAN V BALLINROBE GUARDIANS

We have been instructed by the Irish Medical Association on behalf of Dr. Hanrahan of Hollymount Co. Mayo to apply to the Guardians of Ballinrobe Union for payment of 4 Guineas being the amount of fees due to Doctor Hanrahan ^{at} the rate of 2 Guineas per day for attendance at the Workhouse Hospital, Ballinrobe on Tuesday the 2nd and Wednesday the 3rd Decr. last when he acted as locum tenens for the Doctor of the Infirmary on the requisition of the Workhouse Master.

Unless the above sum be paid to us on or before the 10th inst. our instructions are to take immediate proceedings for recovery of same. In the event of the Guardians refusing to pay, kindly let us have the name of a Solicitor who will accept service on their behalf.
