Mayo County Council have taken delivery of 2 number 4WD Ford Rangers. The vehicles, purchased from Ford, were retrofitted with Vehicle Mounted Signs and other '999' systems by HPMP, Carlow, at a total cost of c. €150,000. The vehicles are 100% capital grant aided and have been put on the run at Castlebar and Ballina Fire Stations to augment our response to Road Traffic and off-road incidents.




