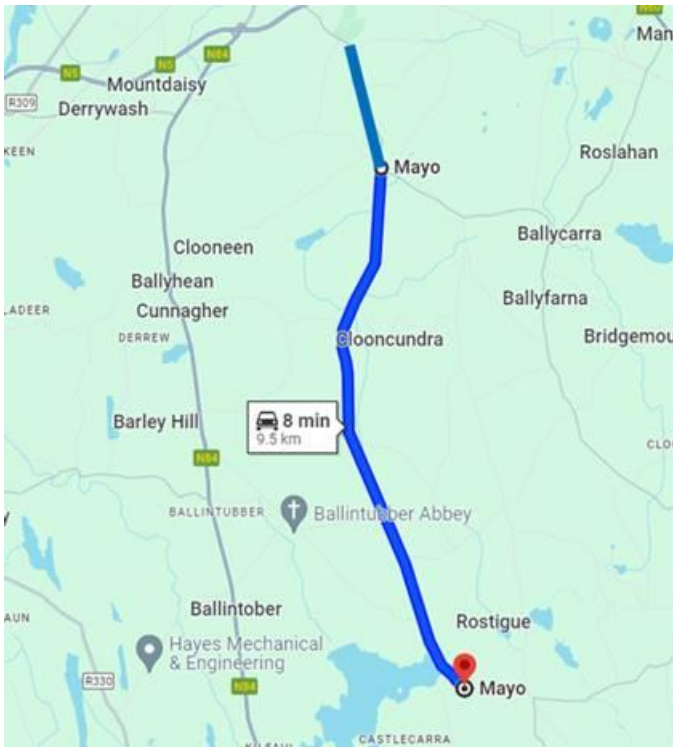
TRAFFIC DISRUPTION

Week Commencing 22nd July 2024

Castlebar Municipal District:

- **N60 Balla to Claremorris (Heathlawn) Road Project Traffic Management**
 - *60 KM/HR roadworks speed limit in place on the N60 for approx. 4.3 KM, East bound starting in the townland of Pollavaddy, through the townlands of Garhawnagh, Carrowgarve, Rathduff, Heathlawn, Brees, Ballintleva, and ending in the townland of Barnagreggaun.*
 - *VMS boards in place on N60, both East bound and West bound – 60 km/hr speed limit and project works.*
 - *24-hour traffic management/traffic signals in operation, single line traffic control, delays expected.*

- **Temporary Road Closure on L-1604 and L-1704 Carnacon to Frenchill via Errew
Tuesday 16th July to Thursday 18th July 08:30-18:00**
 - **Road Surfacing works being carried out; Temporary Road Closure will be in place**
 - **Local diversions in place**
 - **Local roads are not suitable for goods vehicles. Emergency vehicles will be accommodated**



Westport Belmullet Municipal District:

- Road Strengthening Works is due to take place on the R-317 Regional Road at Glenhest, Newport From Thursday 18th July 2024 until Friday 26th July 2024.
 - *Traffic Controls will be in Operation - Please expect delays*
- Roadworks ongoing on the R335 (Murrisk – Lecanvey)
 - *Traffic Lights in operation – Please expect delays and allow extra time for your journey*

Claremorris Swinford Municipal District:

- Footpath works are taking place on the R318 Pontoon Road, Foxford.
 - *Temporary traffic management will be in operation, please expect some delays and allow extra time for your journey.*
- Verge and grass cutting are taking place on the R310 (Pontoon to Knockmore) & R318 (Pontoon to Foxford) commencing Monday 22nd July for a period of 1 week .
 - *Temporary traffic management will be in operation, please expect some delays and allow extra time for your journey*

- Footpath works are scheduled to take place on the R320 Aiden Street in Kiltimagh town.
 - *Temporary traffic management will be in operation, please expect some delays and allow extra time for your journey.*
- Callow Group Water Scheme pipe drilling works are scheduled to commence on the N26 between Callow and the Bonnifinglas junction on the 19th May for a number of weeks.
 - *Temporary traffic management will be in operation, please expect some delays and allow extra time for your journey.*
- Resurfacing and associated civil works are currently taking place at the Pontoon Beach carparks at Lough Cullen, Foxford.
 - *Parking at the beach carparks will be restricted during this time and we apologise for any inconvenience caused.*
- Circet Telecommunications are carrying out repair works in Swinford town.
 - *Temporary traffic management will be in operation please expect delays and allow extra time for your journey.*
- Works for the annual Surface Dressing Programme are taking place at various roads throughout the district and will be ongoing during the summer months.
 - *Temporary traffic management will be in operation.*
- Roadworks are ongoing on local roads only in the Kilkelly Region of the Claremorris Swinford MD.
 - *Traffic control in operation. Minor delays expected*

Ballina Municipal District:

- Road pavement works and footpath rehabilitation works are continuing on the R314 in Killala.
 - *Major Roadworks starting on Market Street, Killala 15th April.*
 - *Church Street will be opened to two way traffic managed by traffic lights.*
 - *HGV's diversions in place.*

- **Ballina Town Centre – Irish Water, Watermain replacement works**
 - *Diversion of HGV's from the town centre will be necessary.*
 - *Dillion Tce / Humbert St - Nightworks ongoing. Temporary traffic management will be in operation. Please expect some delays and allow extra time for your journey.*

- **Roadworks ongoing on the R310 – Ballina to Knockmore**
 - *Traffic Controls will be in Operation – Driver caution is advised*
