Vancancies: At the moment there are two vacancies on the TUS programme at the Fr. Peyton Centre Attymass. The roles are for 1 year, the participant will work 19.5 hours per week, and they must be in receipt of Jobseekers Allowance or Jobseekers Benefit and have been fully unemployed for the past 12 months. The duration of the scheme is 12 months. A small top up is paid on top of your jobseekers Allowance. Persons on the scheme may work legitimately for the remaining 19.5 hours of the week.

Persons coming onto the scheme will have their wages paid into their bank account so it is vital that you have a bank account.

Position 1 – Delivery of the meals on wheels. This person will need to have a full clean driving licence and undergo Garda Vetting.

Position 2 – General Operative – working in the centre carrying out cleaning and any other duties that may be directed by the centre manager.
