

TRAFFIC DISRUPTION

Week Commencing 16th Sept 2024

Castlebar Municipal District:

- Road Resurfacing works will take place on the N60 Balla Village from 8am-6pm, Wednesday 11th September 2024 Friday 20th September 2024.
- > Traffic management in operation, single line traffic control / local diversions.
- Temporary Road Closure will be in place on the R312 Castlebar to Bellacorick road at Beltra to facilitate Road surfacing Works from 9am to 5.30pm from Monday 9th September to Friday 13th September 2024
- > Diversions will be in place via the R316/R315 and R310 via Crossmolina, Lahardane and Pontoon road to Castlebar and also via the R317 and R311 via Newport to Castlebar.
- Local access only only permitted from either side.
- Motorists are advised to use alternative routes where possible.
- Emergency services will be accommodated.



- Road surfacing works will take on R321 at Ballylahan (9.00 am to 5.30 pm) from Monday 16th Sept to Friday 20th Sept 2024 inclusive.
- > Traffic signals or stop/go will be in place and some delays are expected.
- Emergency vehicles will be accommodated.

Westport Belmullet Municipal District:

- Works commencing on Monday next the 26th of August on the R-335 West road close to the junction with the N59 Leenane road
 - > Traffic Management will be in operation
- Roadworks ongoing until early October on the R335 (Murrisk Lecanvey)
- > Traffic Lights in operation Please expect delays and allow extra time for your journey

Claremorris Swinford Municipal District:
