

# Castlebar Municipal District:

- N60 Balla to Claremorris (Heathlawn) Road Project Traffic Management
- ➤ 60 KM/HR roadworks speed limit in place on the N60 for approx. 4.3 KM, East bound starting in the townland of Pollavaddy, throught the townlands of Garhawnagh, Carrowgarve, Rathduff, Heathlawn, Brees, Ballintleva, and ending in the townland of Barnagreggaun.
- > VMS boards in place on N60, both East bound and West bound 60 km/hr speed limit and project works.
- > 24-hour traffic management/traffic signals in operation, single line traffic control, delays expected.
