Mass, Weather Conditions & Public Safety - As we enter into the depths of winter there is a need to plan and prepare for the unexpected. If there is severe frost leading to dangerous road conditions then Saturday evening Mass in Glenisland will be cancelled. Likewise if there is severe frost leading to dangerous road conditions on Sunday morning Mass will be cancelled. People are asked not to enter the grounds or car park of either of the churches if there is frost on the grounds. If there are severe storm warnings for the region, then Saint Patrick's Church, Islandeady and Holy Rosary Church, Glenisland will remain closed for the duration of the storm, and you are asked not to enter the Grounds. If there is a severe storm warning for Mayo on Saturday evening or Sunday morning then Mass in the respective churches of the parish will be cancelled. In the event of Mass being cancelled in either church the Mass intention will carry over to the following Saturday or Sunday.
