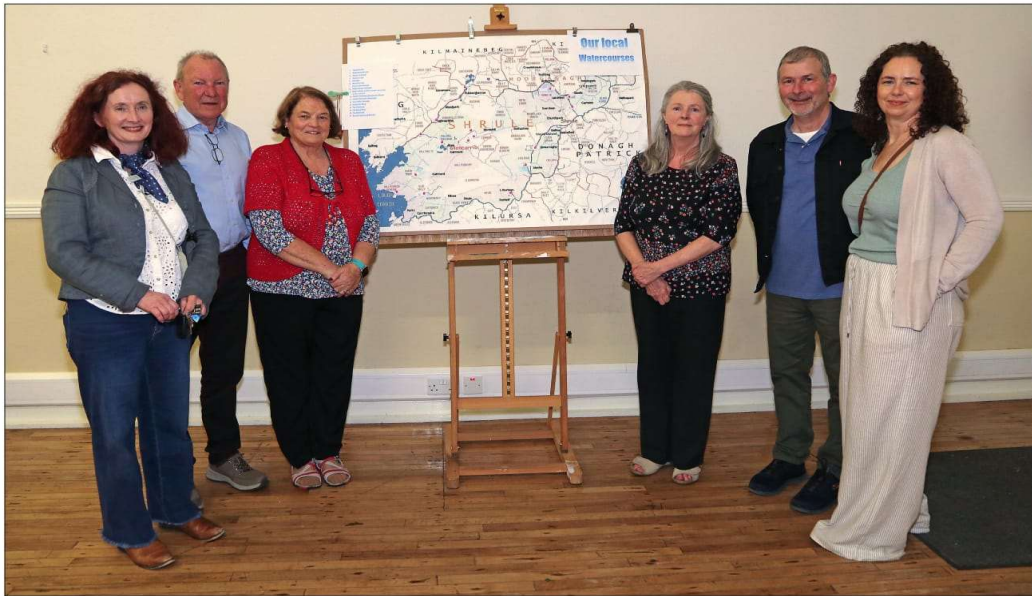

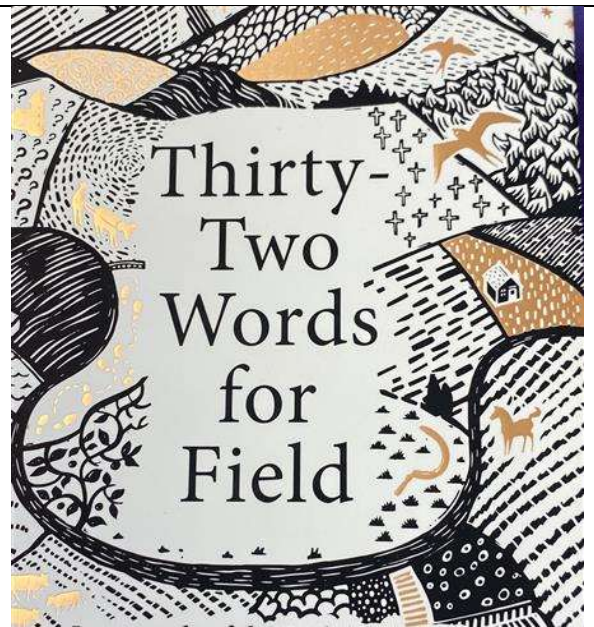
HISTORICAL SGK: PARISH FIELD NAMES.

It's remarkable how a single moment like when Mick Lally (AKA Miley Byrne from the TV series Glenroe) stood on the stage of Glencorrib Community Centre as he launched the Glencorrib NS commemorative when he suggested the recording of field names as a project. His call has inspired us to undertake the important task of preserving the local heritage by recording parish field names. By documenting these names, our community is ensuring that a vital aspect of our history and identity is not lost to time. Field names may seem like small details, but they often carry deep significance, reflecting generations of farming traditions, familial ties, and connections to the land.

As part of our work to record as many of the parish field names before they are lost we are inviting farmers and landowners to drop into Glencorrib Kilroe Community Centre and Shrule Community Centre on the dates that will be advertised over the coming weeks and months.

We will have lots of maps printed available and with your help we can put a name to a field. The name doesn't have to be as elaborate as "Poll a'Mhadra Uisce" (the otter's lair). It can be "the barley field", "the lane" or a family surname which was also very common. It would be nice to record the field names so that future generations will be able to look back at them recorded for posterity.

The first meeting takes in Glencorrib Community Centre on Sunday 26th May after Mass @ approx 10am. We starting off by inviting all farmers and landowners from Ballynalty & Woodpark (from Michael Donohue's house to Ger Noone's house) to come along to Glencorrib community Centre on Sunday 26th from 10am to 12 noon. We won't keep you long but we will have a cuppa tea and refreshments in the hall while you are helping us. If you can be patient with us, we will get to every townland / village in the Parish as the weeks and months progress. There is no obligation whatsoever to attend but if you want to pass the names of your fields to the next generation, the next few weeks / months is the time to do it. 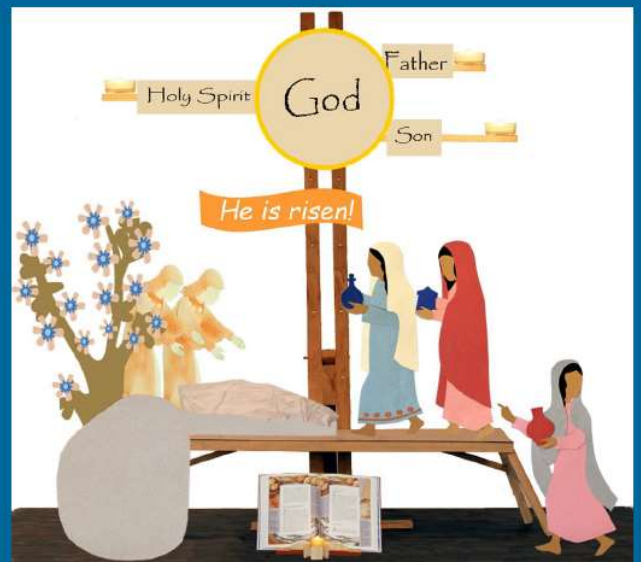
