Reflection

Joseph Mary Plunkett (1887 – 1916) was an Irish nationalist, poet, journalist, and a leader of the 1916 Easter Rising. Plunkett was one of the original members of the IRB Military Committee that was responsible for planning the Easter Rising, and it was largely his plan that was followed when the Rising occurred. The poignant words of the well-known ballad “Grace”, were written in 1985 by Frank and Seán O'Meara. The ballad commemorates the marriage of Grace Gifford (1888 – 1955) to Joseph Mary Plunkett in Kilmainham Gaol on the night of 3 May 1916, just seven hours before he was executed.

Interestingly, Joseph Mary Plunkett was a relative of the last Irish Saint to be canonized, namely, Saint Oliver Plunkett, who was hanged, drawn and quartered at Tyburn in London on 1st July 1681, and was the last Catholic martyr to die in England. Joseph Mary Plunkett had a very Catholic education and was himself very religious. His well known religious poem, titled “I see his blood upon the Rose” has been ranked in 21st place in the top one hundred favourite Irish poems. This poem speaks about seeing Jesus (that is, God) in all things. Members of the Legion of Mary are very fond of this poem because their Legion of Mary hand book finishes with it. It reads as follows: -

I See His Blood upon the Rose
I see his blood upon the rose
And in the stars the glory of his eyes,
His body gleams amid eternal snows,
His tears fall from the skies.
I see his face in every flower;
The thunder and the singing of the birds
Are but his voice—and carven by his power
Rocks are his written words.
All pathways by his feet are worn,
His strong heart stirs the ever-beating sea,
His crown of thorns is twined with every thorn,
His cross is every tree.
